Club AC30 is a regular live music night in London with a focus on shoegaze, post-rock and electronica. Around September last year we came up with a fairly simple idea, asking contemporary artists we love to cover shoegazing classics. The response was more enthusiastic than we had expected, with some sixty artists confirming. This is volume one, the first sixteen...

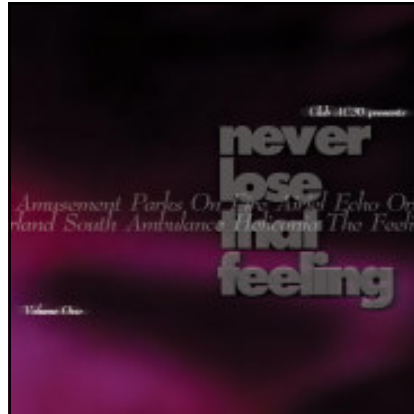
The term **Shoegazing** was coined by the NME in the late 80's to define a genre of noisy guitar bands that came in the wake of grunge. Also labelled **The Scene That Celebrates Itself** due to the key players attending each others gigs, drinking in the same pubs in Camden. This included bands such as **Slowdive, Lush, Ride** and **Chapterhouse**.

The sound was typically layers of feedback drenched guitars over strong melodies, influenced mainly by **Velvet Underground, Jesus & Mary Chain, Cocteau Twins** and **Spacemen 3**.

Fifteen years on and the genre has come to encompass a great many more bands than the initial scene suggested. **Catherine Wheel, The Telescopes, Pale Saints, Curve, Spiritualized, Swervedriver**, and often earlier bands like **House Of Love** and **My Bloody Valentine** are all considered, rightly or wrongly, to be shoegazers. At AC30, we grew up with this music, and the influence is obvious in many of the contemporary bands that we love. Long live shoegazing we cry, Never Lose That Feeling!

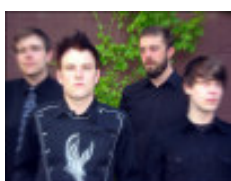
