Biography

Based in NYC, Plumbline has two full length releases on the London based label, Hydrogen Dukebox. The debut album, "Circles" was inspired by a cross country road trip from Los Angeles to New York. Acting as a audio representation of the vast landscapes, the music combines soft tonal melodies and vocal snips, with bits of percussive noises and minimal rhythms.

The second album, "Pin Points" continues with the conceptual theme but this time pulls inspiration from specific buildings in New York. Using audio snippets recorded outside the location of each building as the launching pad, the creative process began as simple percussion. Then adding tones, minimal vocals, and cello as the melodic elements, they evolved into multi-layered soundscapes.

The upcoming Plumbline full length is a collaboration with ambient master, Roger Eno. This time recording sounds and instruments in various buildings and empty churches around the English countryside. The music contains a more organic feel using piano, harmonium, organ and accordion, and delicately combines the signature Plumbline sound with Roger Eno's wonderful melodies. It's slated to be released late Fall/Winter on Hydrogen Dukebox.
